AFGW Fellowship 2010: Application Guidelines

Value: \$4,000

Closing Date: 31 May, 2010

Eligibility: Available to women who are Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia and are enrolled for a PhD degree by research in any Australian university. The funds are to be used for a specific project or purpose for PhD research in any field.

Tenure: minimum 6 months

Applications: must be on the official electronic form by the closing date: 31 May 2010. They should be emailed if at all possible. Email the completed form with all required documents as attachments to:-

If you experience difficulty in supplying a photograph or any other required information electronically, complete the form as fully as possible, email it to the Fellowships Officer immediately advising her that the remaining documents will be sent separately as hard copy. You will receive emailed notification of the receipt of your application.

Your application should provide the following information:-

Ensure that you have attached and/or included the following essential materials:-

- a) Personal data as required on the application form
- b) your contact details
- c) a recent photograph in digital format
- d) evidence of Australian citizenship or permanent residency
- e) evidence of enrolment or acceptance
- f) names and contact details of 2 referees
- g) any other supporting information you wish to add; please keep this to a minimum
- h) signature and date on the application form (typed signature is acceptable on electronic application)

Professional data:

- a) a copy of your academic record and award of degree(s)
- b) details of other fellowships/grants for which you are an applicant or recipient:
- c) publications (if numerous, list the six most important).

Research Proposal:

- degree for which you are enrolled; attach proof of enrolment.
- specific aims of project for which you would use the funds. If this entails overseas travel, explain why the travel is important for the fulfilment of your research
- budget; this should list separately estimated costs of necessary items: e. g. travel, medical expenses, accommodation and food, technical equipment (computers/laptops are normally excluded)
- proposed tenure of the AFGW Fellowship; give details of dates

Employment (if applicable), listing the name and address of most recent employer first.

Any further information about yourself that you consider relevant to the support of your application: Supply a brief list of life activities and community involvement.

Referees: Give the names, positions and contact addresses (including FAX and e-mail) of two independent referees who are familiar with your academic record and who are able to comment on your proposed project.

· DO NOT INCLUDE THESE REPORTS WITH YOUR APPLICATION – REFERENCES WILL BE CALLED FOR BY AFGW.

Conditions of the Award: It is a condition of the award that the successful candidate agrees to acknowledge AFGW support in any publication (including any thesis) that results from the work undertaken and that she provides a report on the conclusion of the project.

NB: Applications must arrive by 31st May 2010. Late applications will not be considered.
